York Area Handicap Doubles Bonanza Rules

1. Use the highest USBC certified average for 21 games or more. Use the 2017/18 season, if no 2017/18 average, use 2016/17 book average. If neither, use current average of 21 games or more.
2. If a bowler's average for 21 games of the current season is 10 pins or higher than his/her 2017/18 average, the bowler must use his/her current average. This applies to all tournaments.
3. Handicap will be 90% of 460 per doubles team for all tournament formats.
4. A doubles team may consist of any combination men and women.
5. Tournament entry fee is \$45 per doubles team, \$25 prize fund, \$15 bowling and \$5 for expenses.
6. Bowl in 5 of the 7 tournaments to be entered into end-of-the-season drawing for the grand prize of a 50-inch flat screen television.
7. Prize fund for each tournament will be determined by number of entries. One in 4 will cash.
8. Barry Sparks is the tournament director. Decisions of the tournament director are final.
9. Tournament is USBC certified.
10. In the event of a tie, the payout for that position, and the subsequent lower position, will be totaled and divided by the number of teams tied to determine the payout to each team. In case of a tie for the final payout spot, the tying teams will split the amount equally.
11. In case of inclement weather, call the hosting center to find out if the tournament will be held.
