TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Hanover Bowling Centre will host the Youth Singles on Saturday February 10th, 2024, at 2pm.
2. Handicap will be based on 100% of 220.
3. Tournament average will be as follows. Bowlers will use the highest average for 21 or more games for 2022-2023 season or current average as of January 27th, 2024. Please provide a standing sheet or average sheet for current average.
4. Pre-entries will be accepted, walk-ins are allowed provided space is available. Entry Fee will be \$35 if paid by January 27th, 2024. After January 27th, walk in entry fee is \$40.
5. Entry Fee must be paid in full by the date tournament is held. Please submit payment by cashier check, or money order, also credit/debit cards are accepted. Credit cards may be processed via a phone call to the bowling center also (717-632-2695). No personal or business checks will be accepted. **Entries with payment may be turned into youth coordinators or mailed to HBC.**
6. The Prize Fund will be paid 100% in scholarships.
7. Tournament bowlers will get 10 minutes of practice on their starting pair. Practice will begin at 2pm
8. Tournament is 5 games across 10 lanes. Total pins with handicap will determine position. Any ties, scholarship will be split.
9. Hanover Bowling Centre will serve as tournament director. Any matters not covered by tournament rules will be decided by tournament director or USBC Rules
